

SPRINKLER FITTER APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

Entry into the Apprenticeship Program

The Apprenticeship Program is a five-year program with on the job training and a 19 Course correspondence through a nationally recognized university. Once you have entered the Apprenticeship Program and have completed your six-month probationary period you will become a member of Local 669. An Apprentice is paid at a percentage of the Journeyman wage. Each six months of the Apprenticeship the apprentice records are reviewed to make sure that there is satisfactory progress both on the-job and in the related training courses. Satisfactory progress means advancement to the next classification and a wage increase until the Apprentice completes the five-year program.

Qualifications

1. Must be at least 18 years old.
2. Must have a high school diploma or GED.
3. Must be physically fit to do the work of the trade.
4. Must have other than dishonorable discharge from the military (if applicable).
5. Must pass appropriate drug test.
