Find out what all of the career buzz is about! The Bizzy Bees Working Together suite introduces occupational awareness imaginatively in a game, workbook and alphabet set that help encourage career exploration at a young age.

Game

Bizzy Bees is a career game for K-3 students. Students can work individually or in small groups to match the 64 Bizzy Bees Occupation Cards to the 16 Career Cluster Hives. There are many other activities the game can be used for.

Workbook

Colorful 40-page workbooks enhance students' career exploration through fun activities. Each activity takes 10-15 minutes. Workbooks are sold in sets of 30, which includes a Teacher Guide with full Career Cluster and Occupation descriptions to complement the activities.

Alphabet Cards

Alphabet Classroom Cards are the perfect addition to the Bizzy Bees Working Together game and workbook. Use them to decorate your classroom with careers from A to Z. The deck includes 26 full-color durable letter cards.

Activities

- Use the Bizzy Bees Occupation Cards as a morning "Occupation of the Day" warm-up discussion starter.
- Use the game to assist in social studies curriculum economics lessons.
- The concept of consumer vs. producer can be challenging to explain to this age group (3rd grade). Clarify this concept by portraying which occupations work in production and which provide services. Do they all fall into the same career clusters?
- Use the cards for Common Core PROBE (Personal Research On Basically Everything). Students randomly select an occupation card, research the occupation with CIS Junior, then write or draw about it.
