




POPULATION GROWTH 2004 - 2014






COMPONENTS OF PERSONAL INCOME BY COUNTY





EMPLOYMENT BY WAGE






SHARE OF JOBS BY INDUSTRY




JOB GROWTH 2001-2014




INDUSTRY WAGES – JEROME COUNTY




INDUSTRY WAGES – TWIN FALLS COUNTY




COMMUTING PATTERN TWIN FALLS COUNTY


Where Residents are Employed


COMMUTING PATTERNS JEROME COUNTY
