CIS Junior is ideal for elementary and middle grades, special populations and environments where refresher or inception career exploration is key.



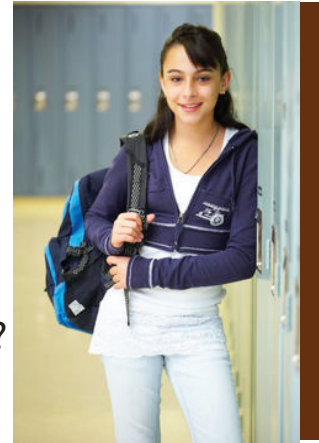
