The U.S. Department of Labor recently announced WIA Program Year 2014 funding allocations. The state's allocations and each local area's share for Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker programs are provided below. Funding allocation formulas used among local areas are the same as applied in the previous WIA program years.

Unfortunately, each program's allocation decreased from last program year by:

Adult: -5.88%
 Youth: -5.76%
 Dislocated Worker: -15.85%
