SUBJECT: Program Year (PY) 2015 WIOA Allocations

The U.S. Department of Labor recently announced WIOA Program Year 2015 funding allocations. The state's allocations and each local area's share for Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker programs are provided below. Funding allocation formulas used among local areas are reviewed annually and applied the same as in the previous WIA program years.

Unfortunately, each program's allocation decreased from last program year by:

Adult: -8.7%

Youth: -8.7%

Dislocated Worker: -23.8%

Total reduction for Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker from PY14 is \$1,400,636.
