- An online system to register for work, search through available jobs and apply for unemployment
- insurance benefits.
- Job referrals.
- Job search workshops.
- Career guidance.
- Job training information.
- Resource center with computers, résumé templates, Internet access, career planning software, Idaho's Career Information System, newspapers, self-help books, videos, mail drop, fax, phones and copiers to use in job-seeking or for unemployment insurance-related activities.
- Information on community services.
- Ability to file complaints.
- Labor market information.
