



Internet Explorer 8.0

1. Click on the "Tools" menu in Internet Explorer.



2. Click "Internet Options".


3. Change to the "Privacy" tab.



Automatic cookie handling

1. Set the slider to "Medium".

Medium

- Blocks third-party cookies that do not have a compact privacy policy
- Blocks third-party cookies that save information that can be used to contact you without your explicit consent
- Restricts first-party cookies that save information that can be used to contact you without your implicit consent



4. Click "OK".


Internet Explorer 7.0

1. Click on the **Tools** popup-menu in Internet Explorer.



2. Click on the **Internet Options** item in the menu - a new window opens.


3. Click on the **Privacy** tab near the top of the window.

5. Save changes by clicking Ok in each window and go to one of the [configuration pages](#) again.

Internet Explorer 6.0


1. Click on the **Tools**-menu in Internet Explorer.
2. Click on the **Internet Options** item in the menu - a new window opens.
3. Click on the **Privacy** tab near the top of the window. (See image below)



4. Move the slider (See image) so that it is on one of the levels below **Medium High** (including Medium, Low, Accept All Cookies).
5. Save changes by clicking Ok.


Internet Explorer 5.0/5.5

1. Click on the **Tools**-menu in Internet Explorer.
2. Click on the **Internet Options** item in the menu - a new window opens.
3. Click on the **Security** tab near the top of the window.



4. Click on the **Custom Level...** button near the bottom of the window.

5. Scroll down to **Cookies** in the new dialog, and set both "**Allow cookies that are stored on your computer**" and "**Allow per-session cookies to Enable**."
