JobScope is an easy-to-use tool to help job seekers and students make informed career and educational decisions through access to education, career and labor market information.

You don't need an account and there's no log-in — just go to www.labor.idaho.gov/jobscape and get started.

You have three search options: 1. type in a keyword, job title or military occupation; 2. select from a list of commonly searched industries; or 3. search all occupations in the database.

1. Enter keyword(s), job title(s) or military occupation(s) to view related jobs
*For example, **registered nurse** or **sergeant**.*

2. Or select from these commonly searched industries
You may select multiple items.

3. Or search all occupations in the database

Information you will find on occupations:

- Related job titles
- Demand (high, average, low)
- Entry-level education required
- Typical hourly / annual wage
- Annual job openings statewide and regionally
- Current number of people employed in the occupation, statewide and regionally
- Programs of study in Idaho
- Link to current job openings listed with the Idaho Department of Labor
- Number of certificates and degrees awarded in Idaho by occupation
