Training and employment

These training programs are open to qualified veterans where funding is available:

- **Veterans Readiness and Employment** – Training services for veterans with service-connected disabilities.
- **GI Bill** – Education, apprenticeships and on-the-job training programs for qualified veterans.
- **Homeless veterans reintegration** - Training and employment for veterans who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

Other important information

Improve your job search with these services:

- **Job Search Workshops** – Dealing with change and transition, selling yourself to the employer, assessing personal skills, tapping into the hidden job market, writing effective resumes and interviewing with confidence.
- **Re-employment Rights** – Your reserve status is protected against discrimination. Find out about returning to a former employer.
- **General information** – Information on community resources such as food, housing, medical and transportation assistance.
- **Unemployment Insurance** – Temporary income for unemployed workers who qualify.
- **Work Opportunity Tax Credit** – Tax benefits for employers who hire veterans like you.
