SUBJECT: Allocation of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 Rapid Response Funds

The following allocation of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 Rapid Response funds are being made in anticipation of increased demand from the release of the Department's June 2, 2009 Pell Grant letter* encouraging Unemployment Insurance claimants to apply for Pell Grants and other financial aid through One-Stop Career Centers and to direct funds to regions which lack funding to meet current or anticipated demands.

Additional base Rapid Response funds remain available to aid those areas that are unable to meet demand with formula WIA funds and the combined base and rapid response ARRA funds. Regions should promptly notify their regional liaison if additional funds are needed so that those applicants seeking to improve skills to become re-employed are not denied services.
