**SUBJECT:** PY 2008 WIA Allocations

U.S. Department of Labor recently announced WIA PY 2008 state allocations, with Idaho's total WIA allocation being reduced more than \$575,000 from last year. This bulletin reflects Idaho's WIA allocations and each local area's share of Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker funds for PY 2008. Formulas used for allocation of PY 2008 funds among local areas continue to be those applied in all previous WIA program year allocations.

Please note that three federal rescissions were also received at the same time as the allocations. Because of the complexity of the formulas involved with each of the rescissions, their impact upon the state's WIA program will not be known until next week. Once those are determined, a new WIAB will follow noting the details of their effect.
