The U.S. Department of Labor recently announced WIA Program Year 2013 funding allocations. The state's allocations and each local area's share for Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker programs are provided below. Formulas used for allocation of funds among local areas are those applied in the previous WIA program year.

Adult program allocations decreased 5.5%. Youth program allocations decreased 10.0%. Dislocated Worker allocations decreased the most at 15.2% from last program year. Overall, the state's WIA allocation was reduced 10.7%
