**SUBJECT:** Program Year (PY) 2016 WIOA Allocations



The U.S. Department of Labor recently announced WIOA Program Year 2016 funding allocations. The state's allocations and each local area's share for Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker programs are provided below. State funding allocation formulas used for local areas mirror federal allocation formulas, and have been approved by the state Workforce Development Council.

Unfortunately, each program's allocation decreased from last program year by:

- Adult: -5.5%
- Youth: -5.5%
- Dislocated Worker: -9.5%
- Total reduction for Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker from PY15 is \$582,621.
