**SUBJECT:** WIOA Transition Eligible Training Provider Policy

On October 19, 2015 the Idaho Workforce Development Council approved the [WIOA Transition Eligible Training Provider policy](#) effective immediately.

All Eligible Training Providers currently on Idaho's Eligible Training Provider list are required to submit a new application by December 20, 2015 to be eligible for WIOA continued eligibility. No WIOA funds may be used for Individual Training Accounts unless the provider is on Idaho's WIOA Eligible Training Provider list.

Out-of-state providers, regardless of their status on another state's ETPL, are not eligible for an Idaho WIOA ITA until further notice.

Providers with high quality programs leading to in-demand occupations with high wages are encouraged to submit applications to become a WIOA Eligible Training Provider.

WIOA funds cannot be used for supportive services to participants attending occupational-skills training by a provider not on the ETP list.
