**SUBJECT:** Workforce Investment Act PY14 Annual Report

**ACTIONS REQUESTED:** Information only.

**BACKGROUND:**

Each state that receives an allotment under the Workforce Investment Act must prepare and submit an Annual Report of performance to the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Act, addressing youth, adult and dislocated worker activities.

Due to states' transition from WIA to the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), this last annual report for WIA was due on December 15. This report, which includes the required performance reports and the narrative, reflects performance outcome information available at the time the Annual Report for the program year is due. This year's report includes a narrative on several activities and initiatives taking place throughout the state and may be found on the Idaho Department of Labor's website at the following link - <http://labor.idaho.gov/wia1/PY2014.pdf>.

This year's annual report contains information on the state's WIA performance, including:

- Performance data on common measures, including progress of local areas in the state in achieving local performance measures;

- Information on participants in the workforce investment system
