- Robust recruitment strategies for priority populations to broaden access
 - veterans, dislocated workers, low skilled, UI claimants, others identified in proposal
- Seamless integration of supportive service strategies; coordination of support within communities
- Use of the One Stop Career Center to provide case management
 - One Stop staff must track all students supported with project funds
- Deliver high quality training that leads to a degree/certificate
- Outreach to employer communities to identify apprenticeship opportunities within the targeted industries
